

# SMBC BOYS VBC: MEDALS & SUCCESSES



In July 2017, SMBC Boys earned yet another Gold Medal at Junior Nationals for a total of nineteen (19) medals earned in a national competition since 2006. SMBC's 26 total medals earned are the second most ever won by any boys volleyball club in the country.



The Santa Monica Beach Club Boys (SMBC Boys) program is the oldest and most successful affiliate of the Los Angeles Volleyball Academy. Established in 1982, and as such now celebrating its thirtieth year of existence, the SMBC Boys program has left an indelible mark on the boys volleyball community.

With 26 medals in Junior Olympic competition—including a pair of gold medals in 2011, silver and bronze in 2013, bronze in 2014, gold and bronze in 2015, two bronze in '16, a gold in '17, and a total of nineteen medals (six gold) since 2006 — SMBC Boys is a well-respected juggernaut with alumni scattered throughout the upper echelons of the collegiate NCAA Division One Men's volleyball ranks (100+ seniors since 2007, playing at USC, UCLA, UC Santa Barbara, Pepperdine, Irvine, Ohio State, Lewis, Pacific, UC San Diego, Cal State Northridge, and others).

The flagship boys program for LAVA—an affiliation of junior volleyball clubs in Southern California featuring some of the best and brightest minds in the region—SMBC Boys has three locations based out of the San Fernando Valley, Santa Clarita, and Thousand Oaks, and brings everything to the table one would expect from a LAVA affiliate and given the historic successes of SMBC Boys— top coaching, structured training, and the superior values and ethics that are so very deeply LAVA.
